

# GENERAL SESSION SPEAKERS

This year's First General Session opening speaker is **Elliot Eisenberg**, **PhD**. Often called the "Stand-up Economist," Eisenberg specializes in making the arcana and minutiae of economics entertaining and relevant. With expertise and consultation sought-out by federal, state and local governments and legislators, hedge funds and investment advisory groups, Eisenberg is an established authority on the national and global economy and its impact on various industries.

The author of more than 85 articles, his much sought-after


research and opinions have been featured in Bloomberg Business Week, Bureau of National Affairs, Forbes and Fortune. He is a regularly featured guest on cable news programs, talk and public radio and authors a syndicated column that deconstructs current issues affecting the economy.

Currently, as the president, chief economist and founder of Graphs and Laughs, LLC, he conducts studies and provides economic forecasts that are featured in daily summaries on his blog. Formerly a senior economist with the National Association of Home Builders, he is an expert on the economic impacts of industries,

Ken Walsh is a journalist and historian who has published nine books on the presidency. He has covered the White House for more than three decades, including the presidencies of Ronald Reagan, George H.W. Bush, Bill Clinton, George W. Bush, Barack Obama, Donald Trump and Joe Biden.

Walsh joined U.S. News & World Report in 1984 as a congressional correspondent and has covered the U.S. presidency, presidential campaigns, and national politics for U.S. News since 1986. Walsh is one of the longest-serving White House correspondents in history

and is now a contributing writer and analyst for U.S. News, specializing in the White House and politics. He served as president of the White House Correspondents' Association from 1994 to 1995,

where he started the association's highly successful scholarship program.

Walsh has twice served as a judge for the Robert F. Kennedy journalism awards. He has won the two most prestigious awards for White House coverage: the Aldo Beckman Award (twice) and the Gerald R. Ford Prize for Distinguished Reporting on the Presidency (three times).

Walsh frequently makes television appearances on networks including ABC, CBS, NBC, CNN, MSNBC, CNBC, Fox News, and C-SPAN, and

is often a guest on radio programs across the country. His freelance work has been published in the Washington Post, the American Journalism Review, and the New Republic.

A third-generation community banker born and raised in Taos, NM, Romero Rainey is the former Chairman and CEO of Centinel Bank of Taos. Upon graduating from Wellesley College, she returned home to Taos with the dream of continuing her family's business of running the town's only local community bank.

Romero Rainey also played a key role in the formation of ICBA's Minority Bank Council and served as its first chairman. Later she was nominated to become a member of ICBA's Executive Committee, and in 2016, became ICBA chairman.

Romero Rainey has also served on the FDIC Advisory Committee on Community Banking and the Kansas City Federal Reserve Community Depository Institution Advisory Council. She has been featured on CSPAN, MSNBC, CNBC, NPR, has testified before Congress, and has delivered speeches before the Federal Reserve, OCC and FDIC.

Romero Rainey is the co-founder of the Bridges Project for Education, a nonprofit focused on helping first-generation college students. She was also selected as Taos Citizen of the Year in 2009 and has been awarded the New Mexico Governor's Award for outstanding women.

Her broader service to the community bank industry began when she joined the board of the Independent Community Bankers of New Mexico, where she served as president in 2007-08. She entered the national stage by becoming active within ICBA and serving on several committees.

Mary Kelly, PhD is an internationally renowned economist, author and speaker who shares her perspective on creating strong leadership, productivity and communication.

A graduate of the U.S. Naval
Academy with a PhD in
economics, Mary learned lessons
in leadership during more than 20







James LaPierre was appointed Regional Director in the FDIC's Kansas City Region in September 2005. He has oversight of all aspects of risk management and consumer compliance supervisory activities for the region.
The Kansas City Region encompasses the states of lowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota and South Dakota.
